LBOA Online Handbook Officials' Compensation

The profession of basketball officiating is rarely a full-time proposition in Canada, but the expectations of all officials representing the LBOA is that each member treats their game assignments professionally and dependably. Generally each season, our Association is in high demand December through March, and members are expected to be available to cover games as much as possible, both weekdays and weekends. Additionally, most members will be expected to be able to travel throughout the region to participate in games.

Officials are treated very well by our schools and clients. Over the years, we have been able to negotiate competitive rates (as compared to other Associations across the two provinces we serve), we receive mileage compensation (when applicable), and we receive a per diem in circumstances when we are officiating three or more games at a particular event. Often times, in lieu of this per diem, our clients choose to provide meals, beverages and snacks to our officiating crew at their event.

Observing and evaluating programs are administered entirely through the LBOA administration. Assignments, as well as process and expectations follow the standards outlined in the Observations and Evaluating section of this Handbook. Defined fees to each official (other than 1st and 2nd year candidates) apply.

happen if two officials are available for the game. Every effort will be made to notify the Game Convenor of the situation in advance of the contest.

Note I – The Assignor, in consultation with the Education Director will be making all Referee Coach assignments. Formal (paid) RC'ing will be performed from the bleachers (observation) and not as a "partner referee." Only one official "coached" per game. RC's will not receive travel compensation for these duties. Plan to package this with other games. Note II - This \$40 will be deducted from the 'evaluatee's' game fee - unless Note III. Every official will be evaluated once. Note III – First and second year (defined as "experience with the game") are exempt from paying the fee.

Note – The definition of first or second year official means the candidates first year as a basketball referee – NOT necessarily the first or second year within the LBOA. An official with 2+ years of legitimate officiating experience should not expect to have this deduction applied to them. LBOA Executive decisions on this experience status is <u>final</u>.

Membership Classifications

We now proudly offer two levels of membership:

- 1. LBOA Primary Member: Home association; priority to LBOA for the majority of assignments; qualifies for full mileage; pays full membership (including mandatory evaluation)
- 2. LBOA Dual Member: Secondary association; sporadic opportunity to receive assignments; no mileage compensation (unless association urgency); pays full membership (excluding mandatory evaluation)

LBOA Code of Ethics "Clip"

It is the expectation of the LBOA that all games are assigned by the Association. If an official expects to remain in 'good standing' with the Association, he/she will not accept any game request made by a coach, league, school, etc., but rather indicate to that person that he/she should contact the Association Assignor to fill the game request.

If it is determined that an official has officiated a non-sanctioned or a sanctioned game without receiving the assignment through the Association, then this official may receive a two-week suspension from the date of the game, from that point forward will be ineligible for Senior High School game assignments for the duration of the season, and will not be eligible for post-season assignments and post season camp / clinic funding.

2023-24 LBOA Mileage Rates

Per Official, Per Kilometer Round Trip

- .55 cents (guaranteed rate for season, irrespective of gas price fluctuation)
- Any day of the week
- Partners travelling together is encouraged when convenient
- Those officials within a 15km radius of the city are exempt from receiving mileage fees
